FIRE PREVENTION AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATION

SMOKE/CO ALARM SAFETY (SHORT)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT identify fire hazards in the home and explain the importance of being proactive by taking preventative measures.

15 minutes

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn about smoke and carbon monoxide alarms. These alarms are located on the ceilings in our homes. Our class will work in groups for this activity.

ACT NOW:

Arrange students in groups of four. Once in groups, ask students to describe what a smoke or carbon monoxide alarm looks like.

ACTIVITY:

EXIT NOW:

Using the answer key found on the Alarm Safety Instructions, review the answers to the questions.
