PLUG INTO SAFETY (LONG)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT identify fire hazards in the home and explain the importance of being proactive by taking preventative measures.

SUGGESTED TIME:

35 minutes

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn about something we all use every day: electrical outlets. Outlets provide a valuable resource, but they must be used safely. We will read a passage and complete a fill-in-the-blank activity.

ACT NOW:

Show the [FDNYSmart Electrical Safety Video](#). After the video, ask the class to share two or three important facts learned in the video.

ACTIVITY:

Use the Plug Into Safety Instructions to begin the fill-in-the-blank activity.

EXIT NOW:

Review the Plug Into Safety Activity Sheet so students can check their work for accuracy.

TEACHER NOTES:

This activity can be done in partners using one Plug Into Safety Activity Sheet. An answer key can be distributed to check other classmates' work.
