3-5 | Objective 2 | Lesson 1



OBJECTIVE

SWBAT respond appropriately to a fire or other emergencies (9-1-1).

SUGGESTED TIME:

15 minutes

MATERIALS:

Stop Drop Roll Cool Call

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn the appropriate steps to take in an emergency. Specifically, if you notice fire on your clothing or if you catch on fire, you need to know these steps in order: STOP DROP ROLL COOL CALL.

ACT NOW:

Raise your hand if you can explain what each step in STOP DROP ROLL COOL CALL means.

ACTIVITY:

Distribute the Stop Drop Roll Cool Call handout. Read the instructions to the class. Students can work independently or in pairs to complete the activity.

EXIT NOW:

Class, what do we do if we catch on fire? Let's say it together: "STOP! DROP! ROLL! COOL! CALL!"

TEACHER NOTES:

Write the first letter of each word (STOP DROP ROLL COOL CALL) on the board. Ask students to volunteer to complete the words on the board.
