FIRE PREVENTION AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATION

SAFE EXITS VISUALIZATION (SHORT)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT recognize the importance of a family escape plan.

SUGGESTED TIME:

15 minutes

MATERIALS:

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn the importance of having an escape plan in case there is a fire in your home. In preparation for creating your own escape plan, let's visualize safe exits in your home.

ACT NOW:

Have students close their eyes while seated at their desks and visualize their bedrooms. Ask 2-3 volunteers to share their visualizations.

ACTIVITY:

Using the Safe Exits Instructions Sheet, pair students for a visualization activity.

EXIT NOW:

Have students cut the activity sheets on the dotted lines to use with their families when planning escape routes.

TEACHER NOTES:

As students visualize, they can sketch their mental images on paper.
