FIRE PREVENTION AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATION

CATEGORY ACTIVITY (SHORT)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT identify trained members who protect the NYC communities—firefighters, police officers, emergency medical technicians (EMTs) (uniforms, equipment, etc.)

SUGGESTED TIME:

15 minutes

MATERIALS:

FDNYSmart Image Sheet FDNYSmart Coloring Sheet

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn about members of the community who can help us in an emergency. First, I will ask you some questions. Then we will do a matching activity, and last, we will color.

ACT NOW:

Raise your hand and share: Who in the community helps people in an emergency?

ACTIVITY:

Project the Image Sheet to identify helping members of the community and each object. Next, call out categories such as firefighters, police officers and emergency medical technicians. Students can come to the board and point to images in each category.

EXIT NOW:

Color one object from the Coloring Sheet.

TEACHER NOTES:

The Image Sheet can be printed and duplicated for each student to circle images as the teacher calls them out.
