FIRE PREVENTION AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATION

GROUP MATCHING (LONG)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT identify trained members who protect the NYC communities—firefighters, police officers, emergency medical technicians (EMTs) (uniforms, equipment, etc.)

SUGGESTED TIME:

30-35 minutes

MATERIALS:

[Location Header Sheets](#)

Scissors, glue sticks, timer (optional)

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn about members of the community who can help us in an emergency. First, I will divide our class into six groups; next, I will give each group an Image Sheet and a Location Header Sheet for a matching activity.

ACT NOW:

Create two sets of three groups. Have students line up, and ask them to count 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, repeating the count until each student is assigned a group number.

ACTIVITY:

Group matching activity

EXIT NOW:

Choose one volunteer from each of the six groups. Each volunteer will pair with the student who is holding the same Location Header Sheet. Students will check their location-matching accuracy.

TEACHER NOTES:

This activity can be a timed challenge.
