FIRE PREVENTION AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATION

FIREHOUSE VIDEO (SHORT)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT identify trained members who protect the NYC communities—firefighters, police officers, emergency medical technicians (EMTs) (uniforms, equipment, etc.)

SUGGESTED TIME:

15 minutes

MATERIALS:

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will watch a firehouse tour video and discuss the importance of NYC firefighters. You will learn about the equipment on their trucks and also the things they wear for protection.

ACT NOW:

Raise your hand if you have ever driven or walked by a firehouse. What did you observe?

ACTIVITY:

Show the [FDNYSmart Virtual Firehouse Tour](#). At the conclusion of the video, use the Firehouse Tour Script to review main points from the video.

EXIT NOW:

Ask students to share three or more facts from the video. Write the facts on the board.

TEACHER NOTES:

Additional questions for class participation:

- Raise your hand if you have a family member or friend who is an emergency worker.
- Raise your hand and share a question you would ask a firefighter.
