# VOCABULARY ACTIVITY (SHORT)

#### **OBJECTIVE**

SWBAT identify trained members who protect the NYC communities—firefighters, police officers, emergency medical technicians (EMTs) (uniforms, equipment, etc.)

#### SUGGESTED TIME:

15 minutes

#### **MATERIALS:**

<u>Vocabulary Activity Instructions Sheet</u> <u>Fire Prevention Vocabulary Activity Sheet</u>

#### **TEACHER SCRIPT:**

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn and practice using important words associated with fire prevention.

#### ACT NOW:

What words do you think of when I say "Fire Prevention"?

#### ACTIVITY:

Students will complete a fill in the blank activity sheet. (If Lesson 3 was not completed, the <u>FDNYSmart Virtual</u> <u>Firehouse Tour</u> (4:26) can be used with this lesson.)

#### **EXIT NOW:**

Ask students to write the 6 completed fill in vocabulary words on the lines provided on the activity sheet.

#### **TEACHER NOTES:**

As an Exit Now option, younger students can trace each completed word on the activity sheet.
