FIRE PREVENTION AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATION

VOCABULARY ACTIVITY (SHORT)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT identify trained members who protect the NYC communities—firefighters, police officers, emergency medical technicians (EMTs) (uniforms, equipment, etc.)

SUGGESTED TIME:

15 minutes

MATERIALS:

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn and practice using important words associated with fire prevention.

ACT NOW:

What words do you think of when I say "Fire Prevention"?

ACTIVITY:

Students will complete a fill in the blank activity sheet. (If Lesson 3 was not completed, the [FDNYSmart Virtual Firehouse Tour](#) (4:26) can be used with this lesson.)

EXIT NOW:

Ask students to write the 6 completed fill in vocabulary words on the lines provided on the activity sheet.

TEACHER NOTES:

As an Exit Now option, younger students can trace each completed word on the activity sheet.
