FIRE PREVENTION AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATION

FDNYSMART GAME (LONG)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT identify trained members who protect the NYC communities—firefighters, police officers, emergency medical technicians (EMTs) (uniforms, equipment, etc.)

SUGGESTED TIME:

25-35 minutes

MATERIALS:

Clear, sealable bags (optional)

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will play an FDNYSmart game to help identify trained members who protect our communities.

ACT NOW:

Look at the image I am holding. Raise your hand if you can identify the trained member of our community. (Repeat five times using various images.)

ACTIVITY:

FDNYSmart Game

EXIT NOW:

Ask students to turn and talk to a partner about how they identify each trained helping member of the community. Have each student place their own set of images in a clear, sealable bag for reuse.

TEACHER NOTES:

Students can work in pairs. If students need assistance cutting, the images can be pre-cut.
