# HOT DOG & SIREN MAZE (SHORT)

#### OBJECTIVE

SWBAT Recognize and distinguish between toys and hazards: matches, lighter, stove, iron, coffee pot, electrical outlets, etc.

#### SUGGESTED TIME:

15 minutes

#### MATERIALS:

[Hot Dog & Siren Maze](#)

#### TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will complete a fun Hot Dog & Siren Maze. These dogs are the FDNY fire mascots. Let's see if you can find a safe way out of the maze by following the non-hazardous path.

#### ACT NOW:

Raise your hand if you can name some of the hazardous objects in your home.

#### ACTIVITY:

Distribute the Hot Dog & Siren Maze to students to complete.

#### EXIT NOW:

Place an "X" over the hazardous objects on the maze.

#### TEACHER NOTES:

Project the maze onto the board and have volunteers come up to trace the non-hazardous path to the exit.
