# FIRE PREVENTION AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATION SMOKE ALARMS (SHORT)

# OBJECTIVE

SWBAT respond appropriately to a fire or other emergencies—know location, answer questions, follow directions, know family action plan.

#### SUGGESTED TIME:

15 minutes

#### MATERIALS:

<u>FDNYSmart Smoke Alarm Passage</u> <u>Be FDNYSmart About Smoke Alarms Video (:43 sec)</u> <u>Pre-printed Exit Now questions (optional)</u>

### TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn how important smoke alarms are and how they can help save lives.

#### ACT NOW:

Raise your hand if you know what a smoke alarm is used for. Raise your hand if you have seen one in your home.

## ACTIVITY:

Project the Smoke Alarm Passage. Read the passage to the class. Stop at each asterisk to pose the question to the class. Volunteers can answer each question. <u>Show the Smoke</u> and Carbon Monoxide Alarms Video.

#### EXIT NOW:

Have students write down one question they will ask a parent or guardian about smoke alarms in their own home.

Use the pre-printed Exit Now questions for younger students who cannot write.
