9-1-1 WHAT TO EXPECT (LONG)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT respond appropriately to a fire or other emergencies—know location, answer questions, follow directions, know family action plan.

SUGGESTED TIME:

25 minutes

MATERIALS:

<u>Calling 9-1-1 What to Expect PDF/Slideshow</u> <u>Call 9-1-1 in Case of Emergency (Video) (1:06)</u>

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn what to expect from a 9-1-1 dispatcher if a call is made to 9-1-1. Pay close attention so you can answer the questions in the slideshow and at the end of the slideshow.

ACT NOW:

What is one reason a person might call 9-1-1?

ACTIVITY:

Use the slideshow to guide the class through a lesson on the importance of providing correct information to a 9-1-1 dispatcher. This content will teach the class what to expect if one were to call 9-1-1. The slideshow is interactive. Can show <u>Call 9-1-1 in Case of Emergency (Video) (1:06)</u> if time permits.

EXIT NOW:

Turn to a classmate and talk about why knowing your location is important.

TEACHER NOTES:

As an Exit Now option, students can work with a partner and act out a 9-1-1 call between a dispatcher and a person in need of help.
