FIRE PREVENTION AND LIFE SAFETY EDUCATION

IMAGINE CIRCLE 9-1-1 (LONG)

OBJECTIVE

SWBAT respond appropriately to a fire or other emergencies—know location, answer questions, follow directions, know family action plan

SUGGESTED TIME:

25 minutes

MATERIALS:

Imagine Circle 9-1-1 Instructions Sheet Yes/No Activity Cards

TEACHER SCRIPT:

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will learn about 9-1-1, which is an important resource in our community. This is a number anyone can call, from any location, at any time, in an emergency. It is important to understand when a child or adult should and should not call 9-1-1.

ACT NOW:

Raise your hand if you have seen a firetruck, police car or ambulance driving fast down the street using their sirens. Do you know how they find out that there is an emergency?

ACTIVITY:

Sitting in a circle, students will decide whether specific scenarios demand a call to 9-1-1. Use the Imagine Circle Instructions Sheet and the Yes/No Activity Cards.

EXIT NOW:

Turn to a friend and give one example of a situation that does not require a call to 9-1-1, and one example that does require a call to 9-1-1.
