## BE PREPARED AND HAVE AN ESCAPE PLAN (LONG)

#### **OBJECTIVE**

SWBAT restate the significance of closing the door in a fire emergency and examine the importance of developing a family escape plan.

## SUGGESTED TIME:

40-45 minutes

## **MATERIALS:**

FDNYSmart Dos and Don'ts
FDNYSmart Escape Plan Grid
Be Prepared and Have an Escape Plan Instructions
Plain white paper

## **TEACHER SCRIPT:**

Today we will discuss fire prevention and life safety (or This week is Fire Prevention Week). We will discuss the importance of having a family escape plan in an emergency. We will also review FDNYSmart Dos and Don'ts regarding fire safety.

#### ACT NOW:

Share the <u>FDNYSmart Dos and Don'ts list</u> with students, or distribute copies. Ask students to review the Dos & Don'ts list.

#### ACTIVITY:

Use the <u>Escape Plan Instructions</u> to guide the activity.

#### **EXIT NOW:**

Have a volunteer share the importance of having a family escape plan.

#### **TEACHER NOTES:**

To shorten the lesson, students can work independently to draft their family escape plans.
